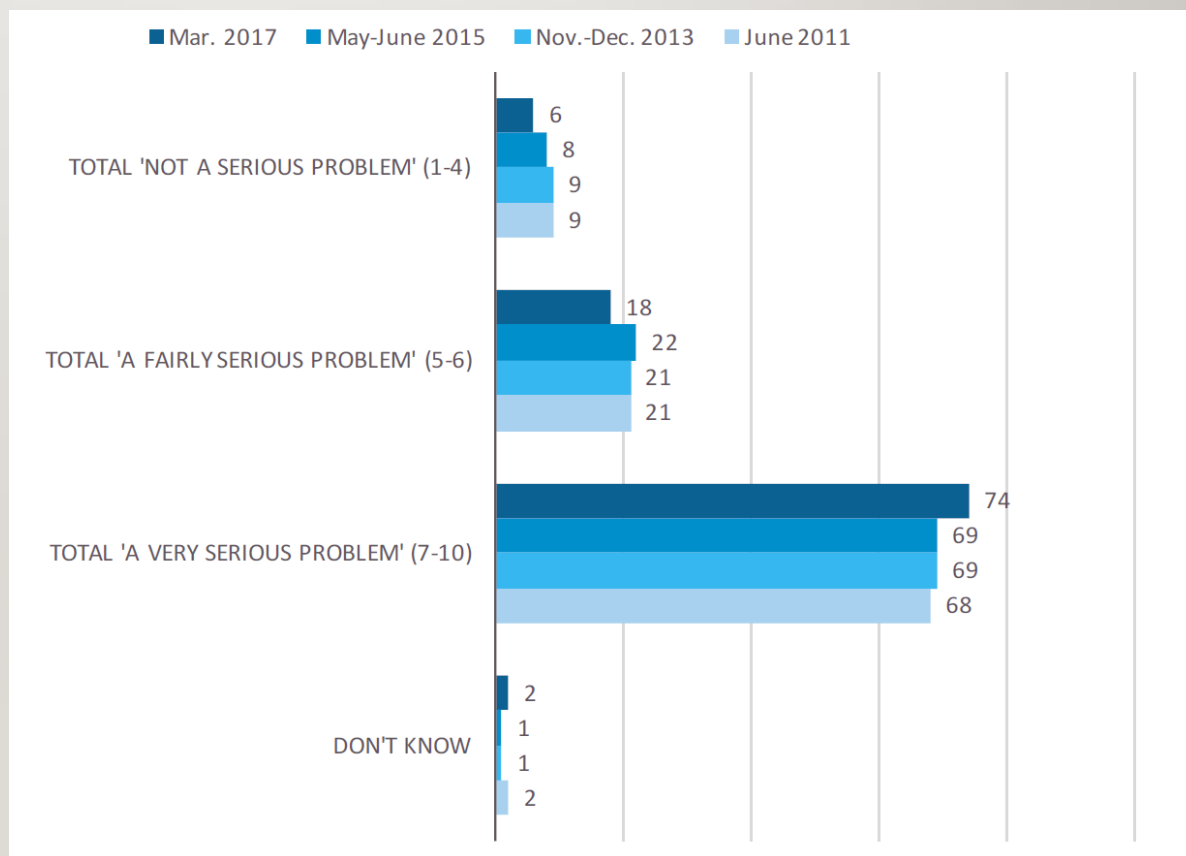

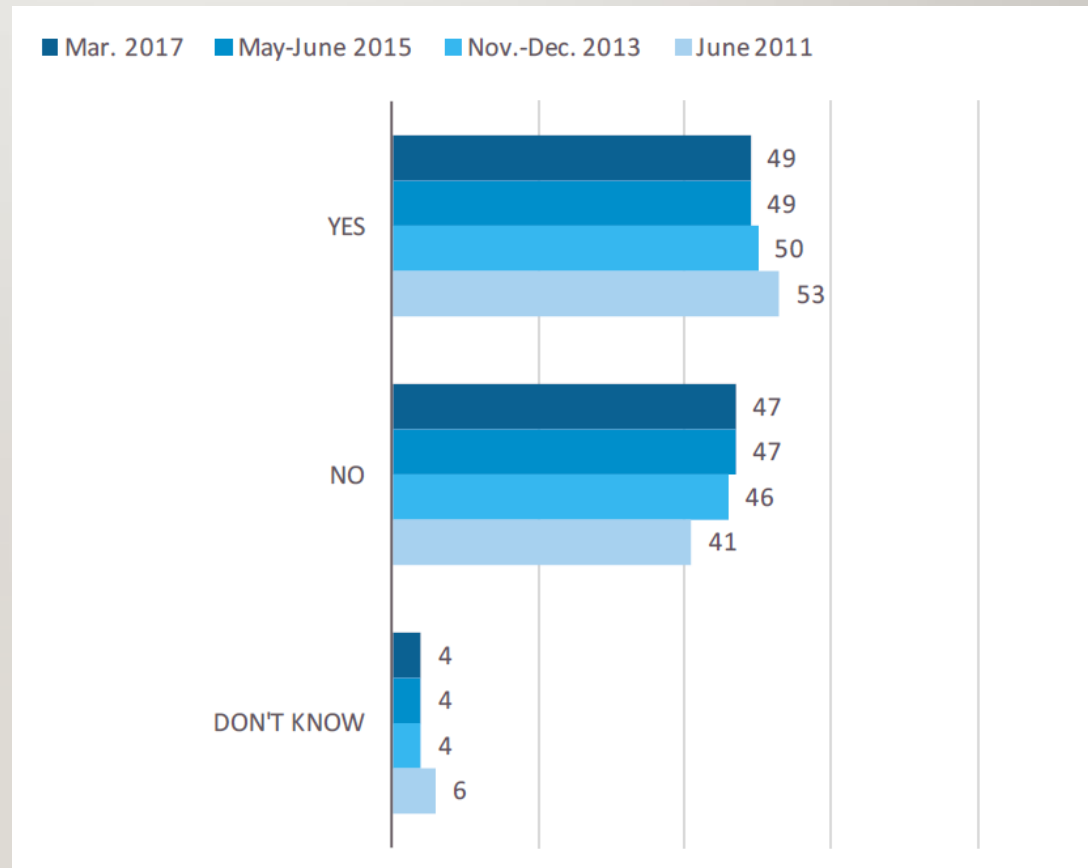
CRESCENTE PREOCCUPAZIONE, SENZA GRANDI DIFFERENZE DI ETÀ, SESSO, ISTRUZIONE

- I tre quarti degli Europei vedono il cambiamento climatico come un grave problema (+5% rispetto al 2015)

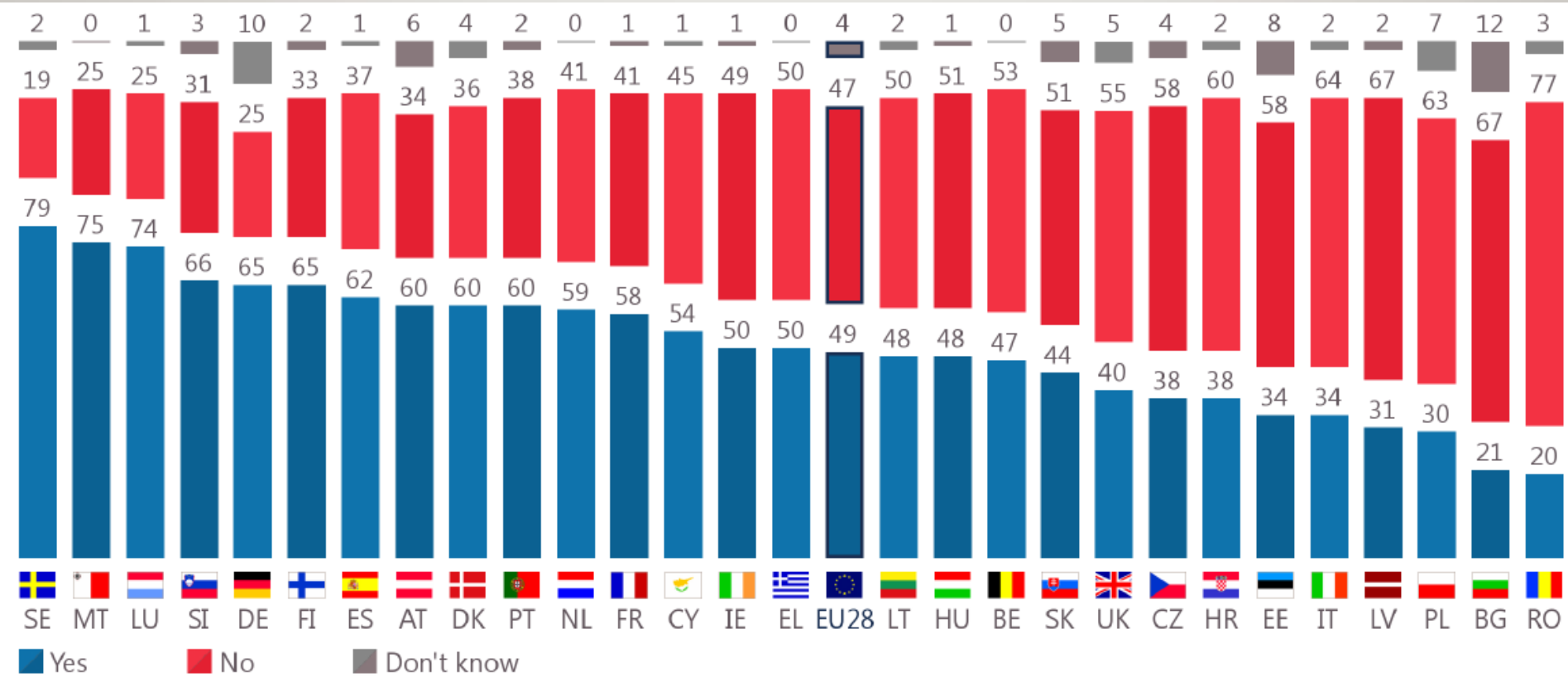


IMPEGNO PERSONALE (ULTIMI SEI MESI)

- Stabile negli ultimi anni, in leggero decremento dal 2011.

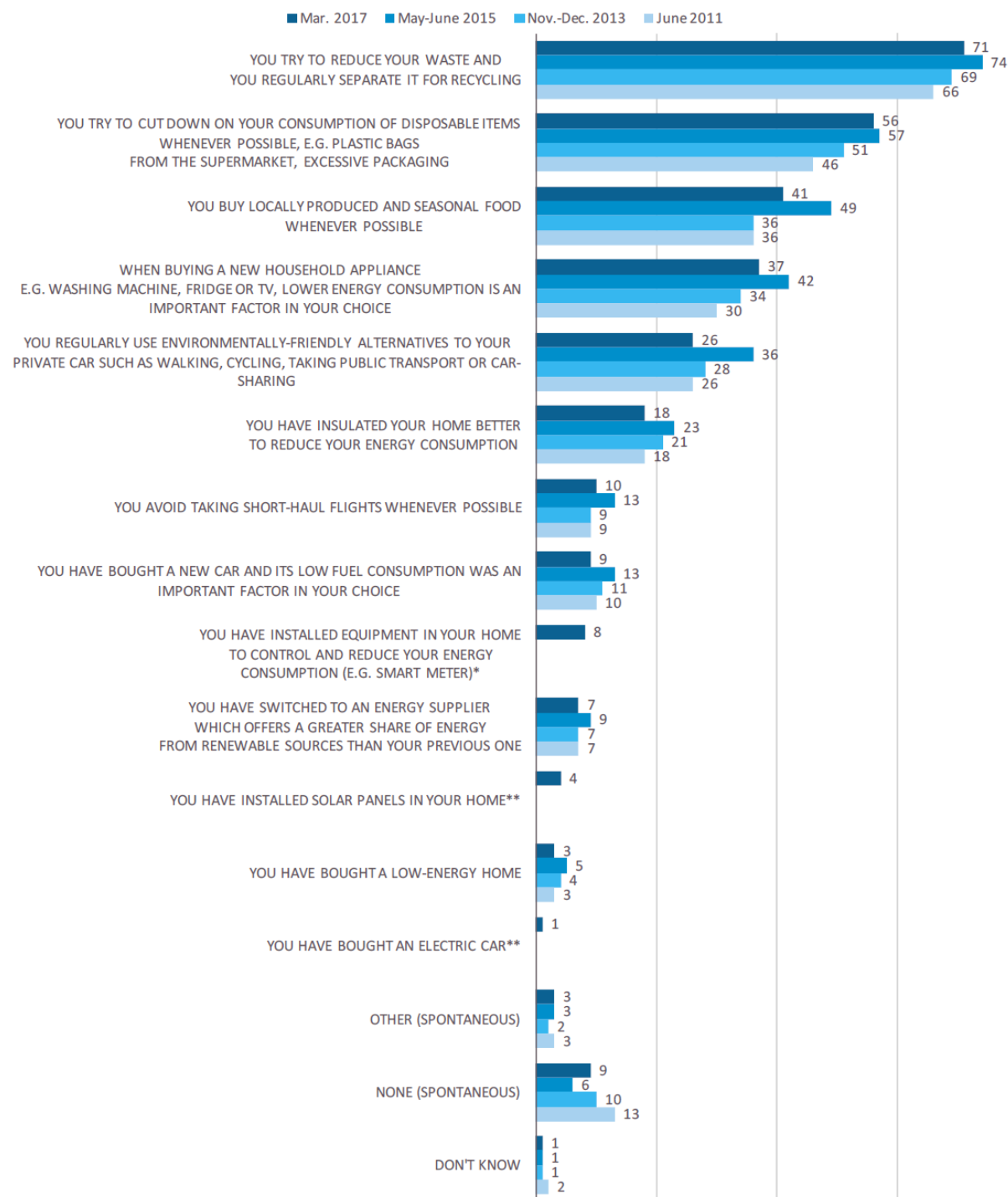


CON FORTI DIFFERENZE TRA PAESI

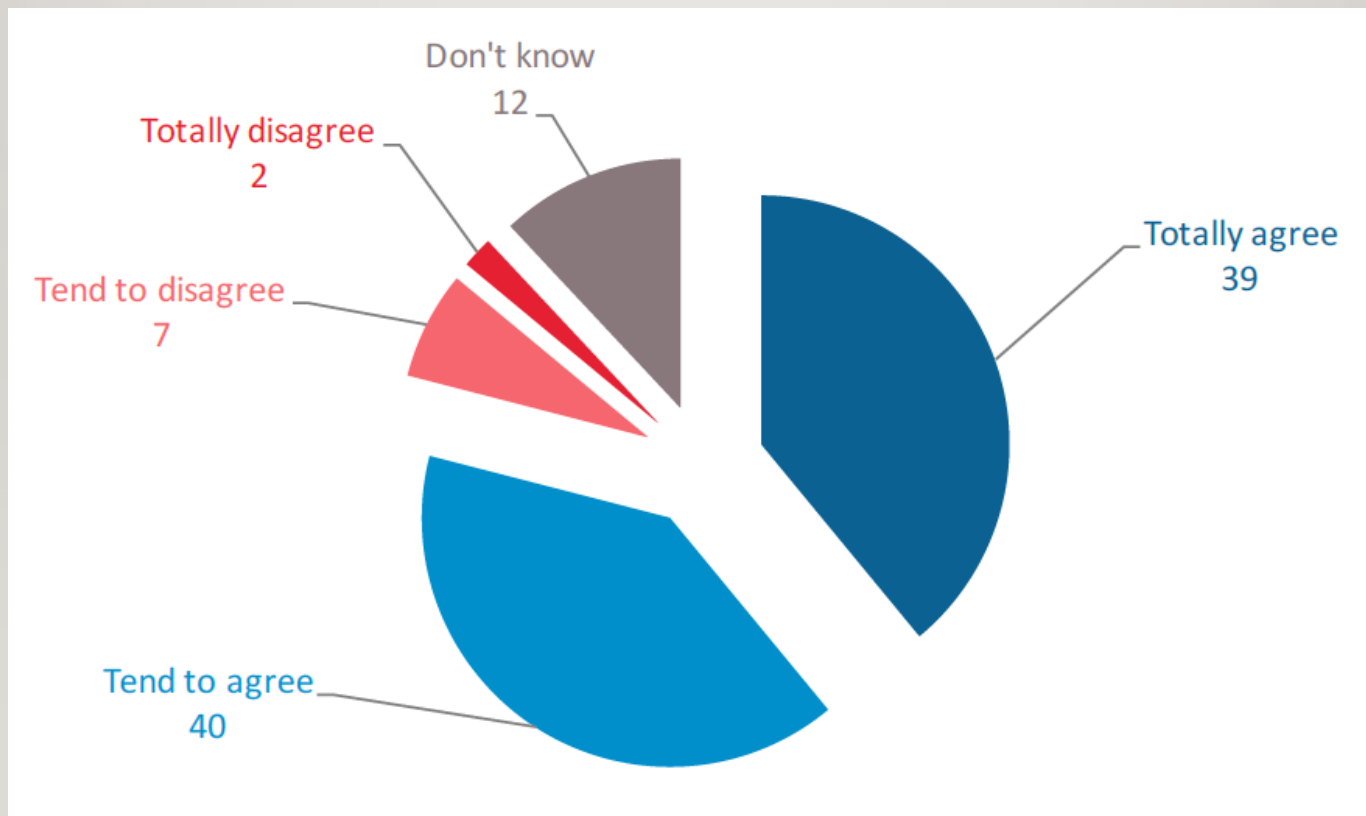
